

Pottery Class Checklist

Item	Importance	Notes
Clothing	Essential	Loose, old clothing that allows for free movement
Shoes	Essential	Closed-toed shoes for protection and pedal control
Sleeves	Recommended	Short or roll-up sleeves to avoid clay contact
Jewelry	Caution	Avoid wearing to prevent damage and interference
Hair Tie/Clips	If Applicable	For those with long hair
Apron	Optional	For extra protection and tool storage
Glasses	If Applicable	Ensure they fit securely
Nail Care	If Applicable	Keep nails short or know how to work with long nails
Dust Mask	Safety	Especially when dealing with dry clay or sanding
Eye Protection	Safety	Useful when mixing glazes or during other splattering activities
Ventilation	Safety	Ensure the workspace is well-ventilated
Chemical Safety Gear	Safety	Gloves and other protective gear when handling glazes
Moisturizer	Optional	For those with sensitive skin
Cotton Gloves	Optional	For those with sensitive skin
Ergonomic Tools	If Applicable	For those with mobility issues
Adjustable Pottery Wheel	If Applicable	For those with mobility issues
